

South Tech Charter Academy, Inc. Board Policy 2.23

Student Transportation

South Tech Academy is determined to make every reasonable effort to provide transportation for students who are otherwise eligible for enrollment and live within a reasonable distance of the school. For the purpose of this policy, a reasonable distance is defined as one requiring a one-way transit time of one hour or less. Transportation will be provided for students living two or more miles from a school as provided by Florida statutes and Department of Education Rule 6A-3.001. Where hazardous routes exist within two miles of the school, the President or Management Company Representative may authorize transportation. The distance is to be measured by the most direct route from the residence of the pupil to the school. Students residing outside the area serviced by school busses will be offered Palm Tran or Tri-Rail passes to a connecting school bus route. Parent reimbursement will be available for parents of special needs students with transportation accommodations included on their IEP or 504 Plan, or for parents of students living in an area which is not serviced by sponsor-contracted school bus routes. Parents of such students will be compensated at the rate of revenue generated by the student in transportation FTE funds.
